A Message from our Minister

On one occasion when Jesus had finished praying, His disciples approached Him afterwards and asked Him to teach them to pray just as John the Baptist taught his disciples to pray. In reply Jesus said to them the pattern prayer we have come to know as the Lord's Prayer.

Following this, He went on to tell them a story to illustrate continuous, importunate prayer. He tells of a man who goes to his friend at midnight and asks of him food. Jesus says that the friend will give him what He asks for not because he is his friend but because of his persistence in asking. He would not leave until he received food.

Just like this man who sought food from his friend, Jesus wants us to come and ask God for what we need, and just as this man who would not go without receiving what he went for so Jesus wills us to do the same. Let us not give up or grow discouraged in our prayers, rather let us put our trust in God and continually pray to Him knowing that He is not a reluctant friend unwilling to give but a God who is more than willing to answer the prayers of those who look to Him and seek His face.
