#### **Update from the Trustees**

After many years of dedicated service, most of the time as Trust Secretary, Brian Deakin has resigned as a Trustee owing to recent health issues. We are grateful to Brian for his work and commitment to the church over the years. We pray for his and Janice's good health for the future and look forward to seeing them at church for many years to come.
