As we prepare for the end of the year, many of us will be busy organising and planning as Christmas draws ever closer. For many people and especially Christians, Christmas is an important and special time of the year. Many choose to remember and celebrate the birth of the Lord Jesus Christ and His coming into the world.

In Luke's account of Jesus birth, he recalls how there were shepherds in the field tending to their sheep at night and whilst tending an angel appeared to them and told them of Jesus birth. The angel's opening line was "... I bring you good tidings of great joy which will be to all people ..."

As we approach this busy time of year let us remember that God did not send angels to the noble born or to the priests or religious leaders, but to lowly shepherds in a field.
