
## The Holy Spirit Builds God's Team – Gifts to Give




#### Game

Football teams draft football players to build the right mix for their team's success. The need for different athletes to fill the different positions. The Holy Spirit builds God's team, the church. It operates best with different players in the right positions, called spiritual gifts, special abilities believers use in serving Christ. Every believer has at least one because the spirit gives them to each one, just as he determines 1 Corinthians 12:11.

The Bible records several lists of spiritual gifts (Romans 12:6-8, 1Corinthians 12:8-10, Ephesians 4:11)

Ephesians 2:21-22, "In Him the whole building is joined together and rises to become a holy temple in the Lord. And in Him you too are being built together to become a dwelling in which God lives by His Spirit."

This means that we are stronger together than we ever would be on our own!

This is what we would call the church: not a building or place to go on Sunday mornings, but a group of believers who honour God together. Let's each welcome the Holy Spirit with our hearts and homes. And together, let's stick together to be the church.

## Let's find the church body parts?

God has given his people special gifts to share with others for the good of the whole church. What might this mean for you?

In the letter from Paul to the Corinthians, we hear him talk about how, as Christians, we all belong to the Body of Christ. And just like there are different body parts that do different things, we have different tasks that God calls us to do.

But we need something to guide us so that we know what our tasks are and how we fit together. Because if the ear tries to help the body run down the road, that's really going to hurt and if the knee tries to eat a jam sandwich, well that's going to be messy.

So, for us to best participate in the Body of Christ, we have to know what it is that we're supposed to do. And the way the parts of a body know what to do is that they listen to the brain. The same is true for the Body of Christ.
