Name your gift

Affectionate – I like to show love

Giving – I like to share

Teacher – I like to help others learn how to do things

Patient – I can wait without getting upset

Humorous – I can make people laugh by the things I say and do

Hard worker – I don't quit until the job is done

Reliable – You can depend on me to do what you ask

Friend – I am kind and love to be friendly

Honest - I tell the truth
