- Believers are humble. *Philippians 2:3*
- Believers stimulate one another to do good works. *Hebrews 10:24*
- Believers don't slander one another. *James 4:11*
- Believers don't complain against one another. *James 5:9*
- Believers confess their sins to one another and pray for one another. *James 5:16*
- Believers extend hospitality to one another. *1 Peter 4:9*
